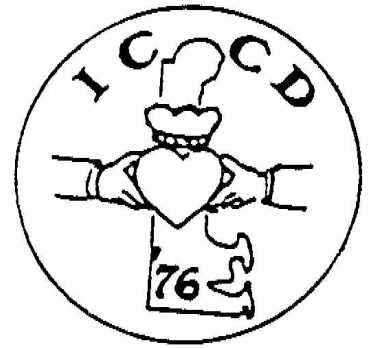

Schedule:

Beginner is a competitor who has not taken Irish dancing lessons from a registered teacher to September 1st of previous year. A Beginner must move into Advanced Beginner the following year.

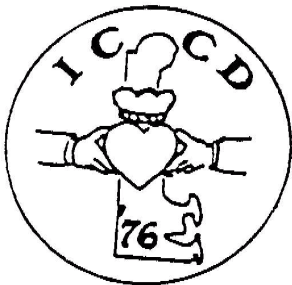
